BACKGROUND

261 Fearless Club Banbury is part of a global movement that uses running to empower women, breaking down barriers to participation and creating supportive networks that extend beyond sport. The club, led locally by Amy Russell, provides opportunities for women of all ages and abilities to discover the joy of running in a safe and welcoming environment.

Through Legacy Leisure's Community Grant Funding, the club has been able to purchase new head torches and high-visibility kit. These essential items ensure that members can continue to run safely throughout the darker winter months, maintaining participation and building confidence.

The impact of this support extends far beyond the weekly sessions. By reducing safety concerns, the grant encourages more women to stay active year-round, promoting physical health, mental

wellbeing, and community connection. As the club explained, "the funding will continue to encourage females within Banbury to get involved with running within a supportive environment, as well as pressure and judgement free, while progressing in their running journey."

Through this partnership with 261 Fearless Club Banbury, Legacy Leisure is helping to strengthen opportunities for women in sport and empower more people to embrace running as a lifelong activity.
