BACKGROUND

The Grange Community Primary School received funding via Legacy Leisure's community grant scheme to contribute towards the build of a new outdoor gym for pupils at the school.

Local to Woodgreen Leisure Centre, the Grange has over 300 pupils aged 4 to 11 years old. Combining funding from Legacy Leisure with government funding, as well as a contribution from its local church, the Grange is now home to an outdoor gym with a wide range of equipment specially designed for children. Equipment includes:

- Double Health Walker
- · Double Slalom Skier
- Rower
- Horse Rider
- Sky Stepper
- · Arm and Pedal Bike
- Double Sit Up Bench
- Monkey Bars

Rubber mulch was also installed to provide a safe and protective surface for children using the outdoor space.

Feedback from the pupils has been very positive, with many using the outdoor gym during lunchtime breaks. The gym has also facilitated the introduction of a new Summer Term after-school fitness club, aimed at developing the physical literacy skills of Key Stage 2 children in a safe, fun, and motivating environment. Children are also encouraged to take part in fun personal challenges using the equipment.
