OVERVIEW

One of the first contracts to go live with the new system was North Somerset. We caught up with the Team at Hutton Moor Leisure Centre, to see how they had been finding it.

Although they have only been using the system since the end of March, they have already processed over 80 referrals.

Initial reports confirm that the team are really enjoying using the new system and that moving to an entirely secure, online platform has made things much easier than having to manage paper records. They like that everything is now in one place and appreciate the simplified referral pathway which allows their regular referrers to quickly refer their patients to appropriate support.

The team anticipate that the system will allow them to become more efficient with their time management. This in turn, will allow them to support even more service users.

Their engagement with Primary Care has also improved; Kylie Taylor, Sales & Marketing Manager at Hutton Moor said:

"it has already given us a better relationship with the GP's as we are now have even greater security measures in place.
